2. Dale requested that the CARF System Options meeting minutes be added to next meeting's agenda.
3. Discussed minimum credit requirement for grad programs:
 - HLC expects grad programs to be 30 or more credit hours
 - If a program is less than 30 credit hours, reason must be justified
 - Concern was raised that a 30 credit hour requirement would disadvantage our students
 - However, we should take care that most of our grad programs meet the requirement
 - It was agreed that, so long as nothing needs doing retroactively, any program of less than 30 credits provide justification
